



Thanksgiving Dinner - Help is Available

Thanksgiving Day is Thursday, November 23, 2017

Following is information for folks who need assistance providing their families with a hearty Thanksgiving meal. The deadlines to apply for Thanksgiving assistance vary by agency, so please plan ahead and don't let the deadlines pass you by. To make certain everyone who needs help can receive it, applicants are asked to choose from just one of the following agencies for their Thanksgiving meal needs.

Call the Glory Hole to sign-up for a box; a deadline to apply has not yet been set, but it's better NOT to wait. Call soon! You will need to tell them your name, your telephone number, the number of people in your family, and the date/time you would like to pick up your box. Boxes are being picked up at Holy Trinity Episcopal Church on 325 Gold Street, downtown.

The choices for box pick up are:

Sunday, November 19	11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. OR 4:30 to 7 p.m.
Monday, November 20	4:30 to 7 p.m.
Tuesday, November 21	11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. OR 4:30 to 7 p.m.

Stop by the office on Teal Street within the following times **ONLY** to apply for a Thanksgiving food box: **9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekdays between November 1 to 8** (office closed Saturday and Sunday). When you apply you must show identification. This year, folks have a choice between picking up their basket on Saturday, November 18 or having it home delivered on Sunday, November 19. The office staff will give you more details when you apply for a basket.
